

Jhoon Rhee TKD: Leadership Tip Requirement (ver 10.2016)

The Leadership Tip is a requirement for all advanced belt students starting at Red Belt. Students are required to complete 10 leadership classes in order to achieve the Leadership tip for your next rank. The parameters for the leadership participation are listed below. If you are *assisting* in class, please remember to sign up on the clipboard by the attendance cards. This is YOUR responsibility; do not call the school to add your name to the list. Students who are *participating* in class for the leadership credit, do not have to sign up in advance; simply show up as usual. If you cannot attend the class you registered for, please call the school. All Leadership students must arrive on time in full uniform. If you are late (regardless of the reason) you will not be allowed to participate.

- **When participating or assisting in class, respond LOUDLY to all instructor commands “Yes Ma’am!/Yes Sir!”**
- **Lead by example. Lower ranked students are looking up to you so it’s important to set a positive example**
- **Motivate & encourage students. Give them high fives or tell them they are doing a good job.**
- **Perform curriculum demonstrations. Be focused and look sharp.**
- **Arrive on time in FULL uniform. No T shirts.**
